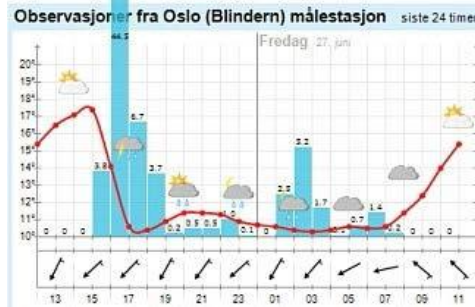

# More intense precipitation events. New record in Oslo June 2014

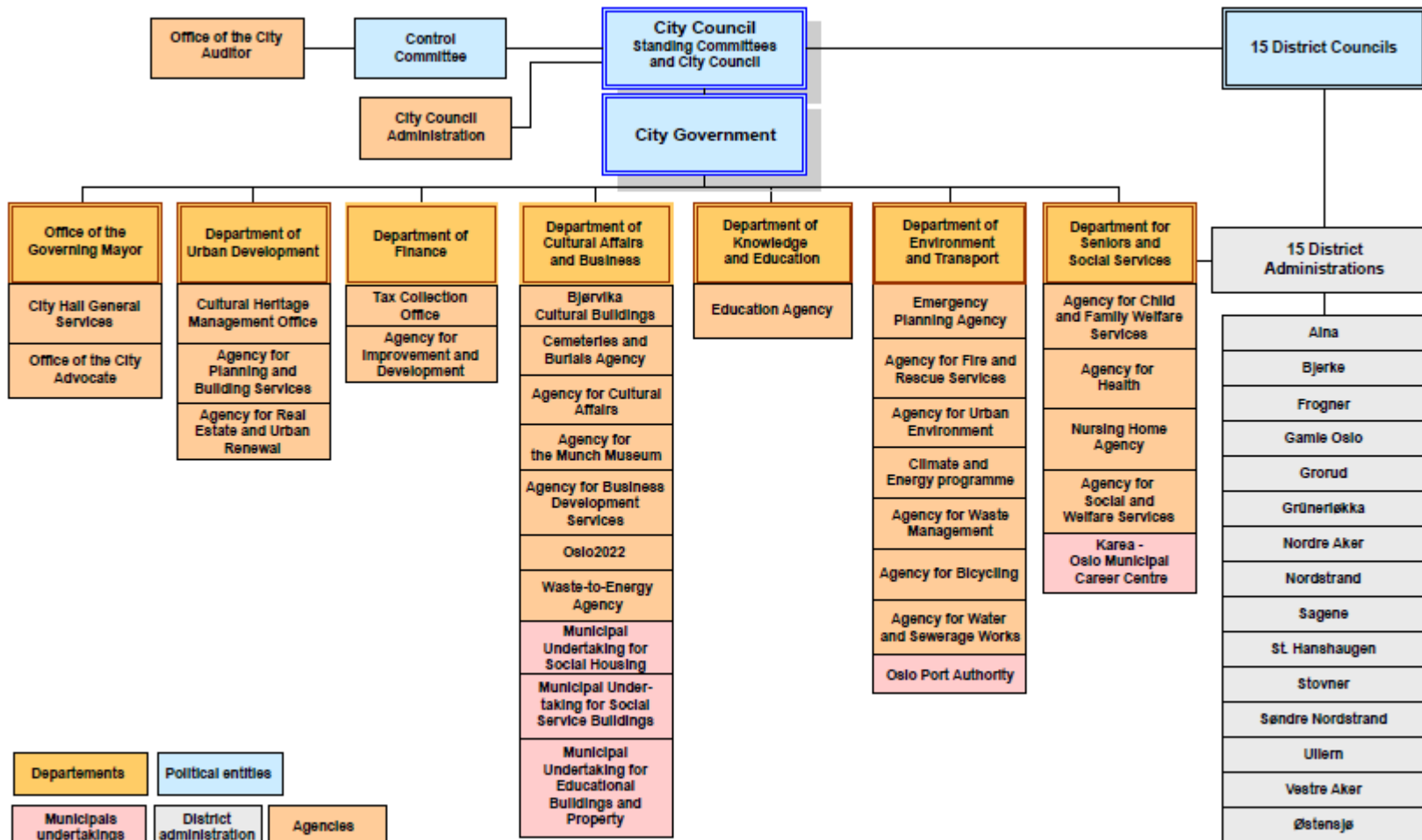


HEAT: Climate modelling: the Oslo-region will have temperatur close up to 40 degrees Celsius in 2050

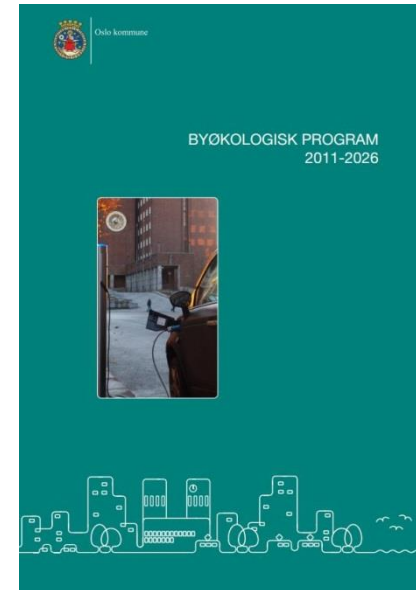

Oslo is a co-member of the C40 network



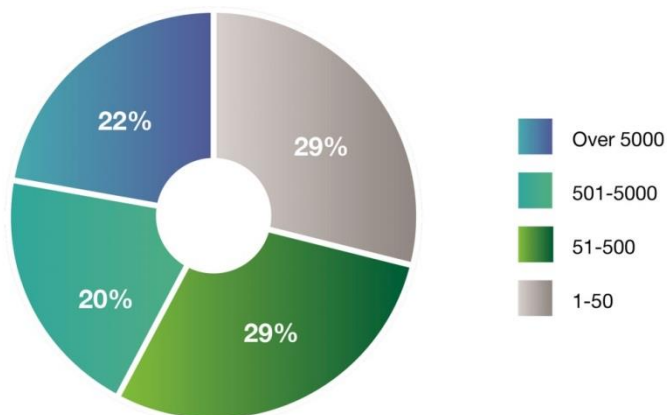

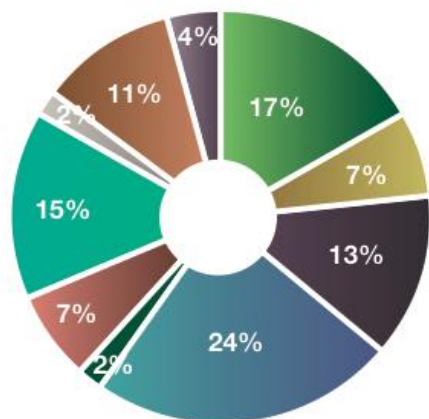

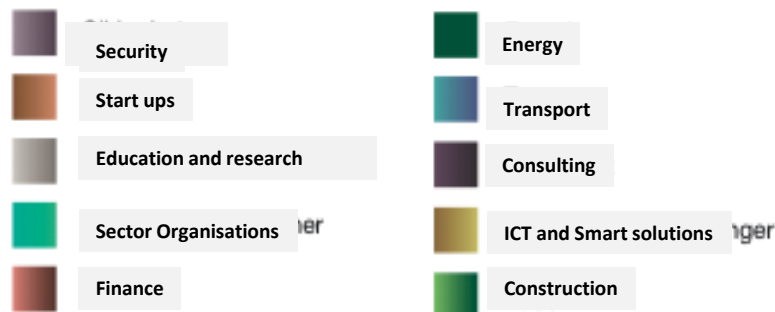

# Environment certification – a road to a more effective resource management

## Eco-Lighthouse:

Norwegian standard for small and medium sized enterprises

### Result in Oslo:

- 379 municipal units
- 598 private and public (state) units
- 447 units to go
- 216 units can not receive a certificate

## ISO 14001

- 8 municipal agencies
